



Administrators and EBLI Training

What does EBLI recommend?

We highly recommend that Administrators attend all 3 days of EBLI Training (at no cost). There is a big difference between schools/districts that have informed Administrators who are knowledgeable about EBLI and those that do not. Administrators who attend training are better able to assist their teachers with questions about EBLI and direct them to the EBLI resources. EBLI also requires a paradigm shift from educators because it differs quite substantially from traditional literacy instruction, so it is ideal for Administrators to take part in training.

Who counts as an Administrator?

Superintendents, Curriculum Directors, Principals, Assistant Principals, and Deans count as Administrators.

What are Administrator options for attending training?

- Once training is complete, Administrators may use EBLI to teach students. They are **contractually prohibited** from teaching other educators how to teach EBLI.
